

Work Requirement



Activities

Report Each Month to Keep Health Insurance:

- Working and making less than \$740 a month before taxes
- Attending school, vocational or job training less than full time
- Volunteering
- Job searching & job search training. (Up to 39 hours a month)
- Attending health education classes. (Up to 20 hours a year)
- Meeting SNAP work requirement

*Must report at least 80 hours of work and community engagement activities a month.



Exemptions

Make sure DHS knows if you:

- Receive TEA Cash Assistance.
- Receive Unemployment Benefits.
- Work and make more than \$740 a month before taxes.
- Have a disability or need help with daily living activities. (Includes blindness)
- Have a child under 18 living in your home.
- Are pregnant or were pregnant within last 60 days.
- Care for a person who cannot care of him or herself.
- Can't work or look for work because of a short-term disability.
- Attend an alcohol or drug treatment program.
- Go to school, vocational, or job training full time.

*Some exemptions must be reported every 2 or 6 months.

Report your activities and exemptions by the 5th of the following month.
